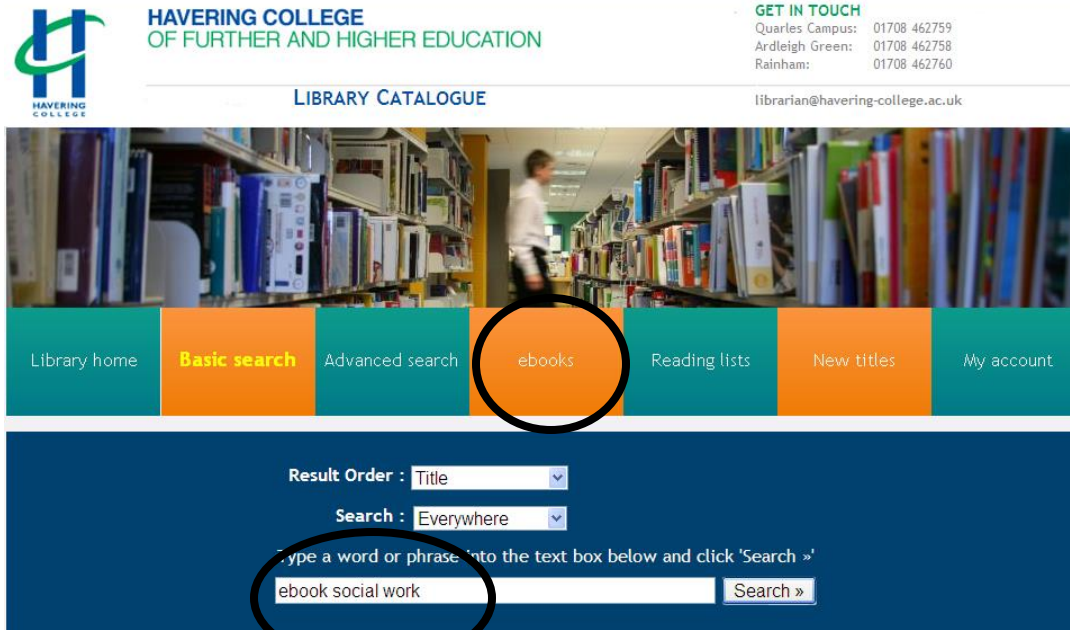




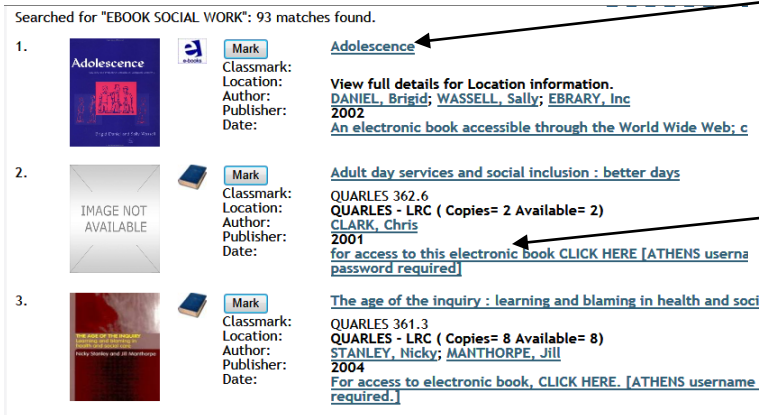
No. 3 HOW TO ... ACCESS AN eBook VIA iPAC

Electronic books can be accessed via the library catalogue, iPAC. You may need an ATHENS username and password too.

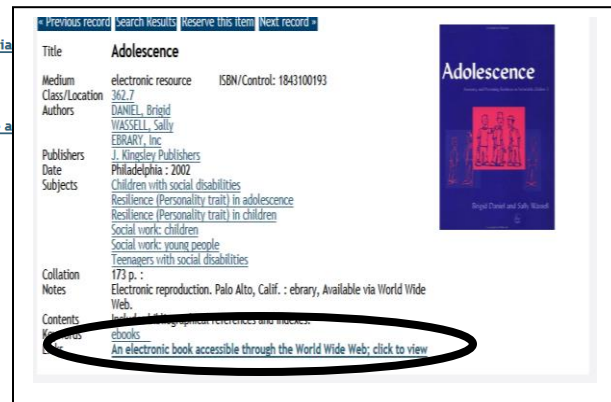
1. On the iPAC home page, select the *ebooks* button, then refine your search by typing *a search term or the subject you are interested in* e.g. **social work**, the successful 'hits' are then listed. Alternatively, type *ebook* **subject** the Basic Search box.

Click on the title of the book that you are interested in. When the new screen loads, click on the LINK to access the eBook. You may need your ATHENS username and password. Alternatively, click on the link on the title screen.



4. You may be requested to login to 'ATHENS'. [Use the login details sent to your Office365 email account.] After the ATHENS login, the book details screen appears.
