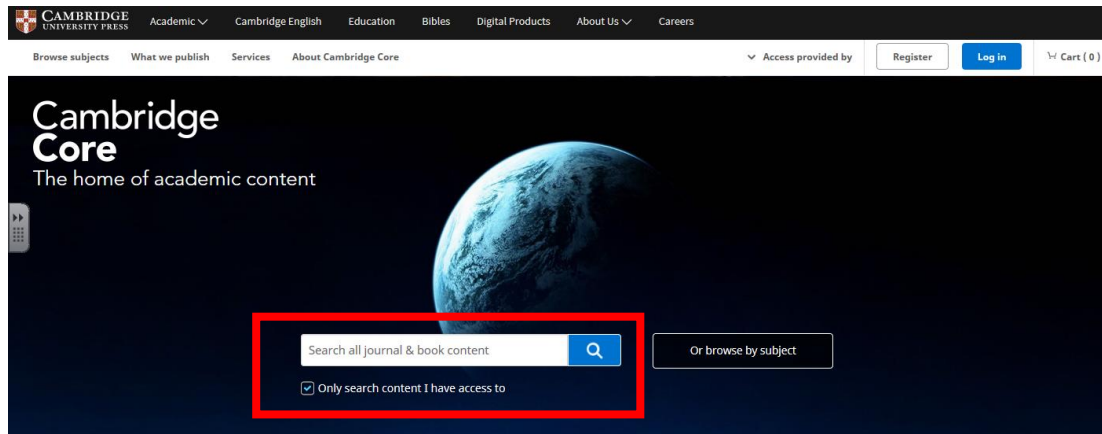


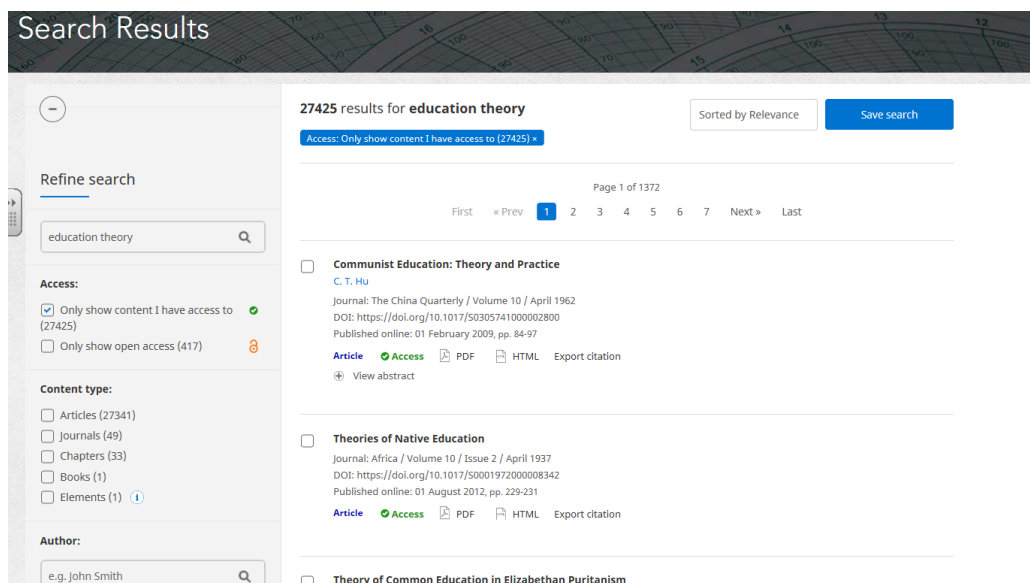


## No 6 HOW TO ...access Cambridge Core Journals

1. **Cambridge Core Journals** is a multidisciplinary database covering subjects including Education, Engineering, Management, Music, Psychiatry and Social Science.
2. It can be accessed directly from <http://journals.cambridge.org/> or from the LRC's Moodle pages – Online Resources or your Athens account if off-campus.

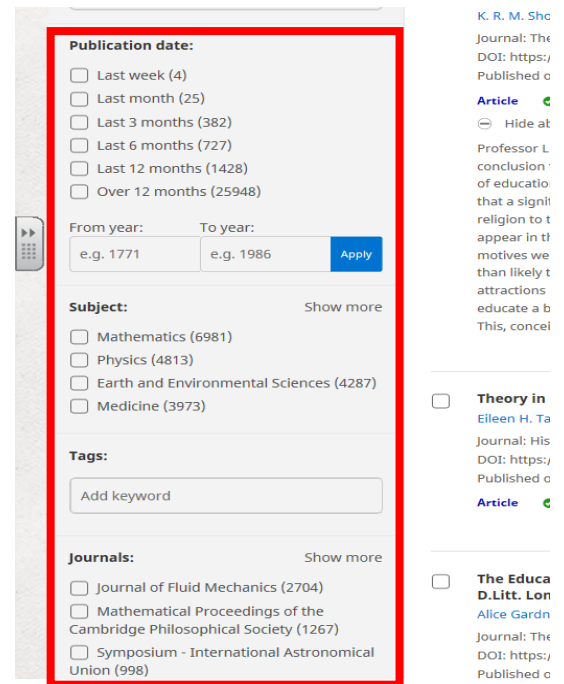
4. Tick the box marked **'ONLY SEARCH CONTENT I HAVE ACCESS TO'** and then add your search term in the box above.
5. For example, the results for a search 'Education theory' would appear as below:



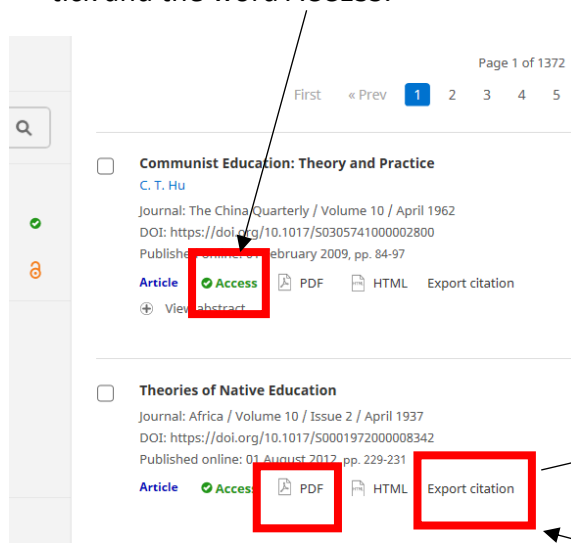
The **REFINE SEARCH** panel on the left of the screen allows you to reduce the number of 'hits' by adding:

- A date or range of dates
- A refinement by subject
- Tags (Keywords) e.g. useful words or phrases
- Selecting specific journal titles

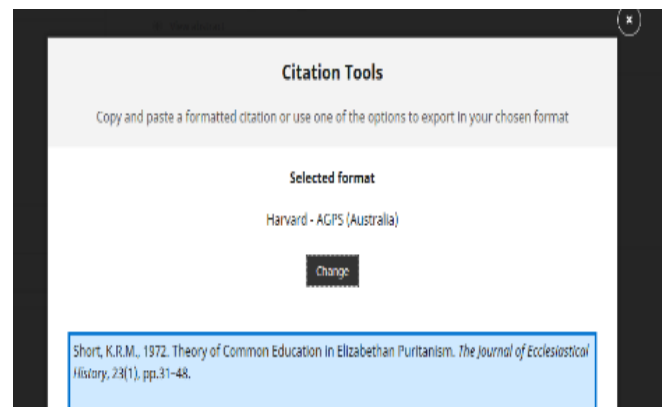
The more of these refinements you add, the more your 'hits' will reduce.



6. Scroll further down to see the articles. Those freely available are marked with a green tick and the word **ACCESS**.



7. Click on the PDF to see the article.



8. Click on EXPORT CITATION to create a reference for your article.

Select the **CHANGE** box and look for **Harvard – AGPS (Australia)** as this most closely resembles the Havering College version of Harvard.
